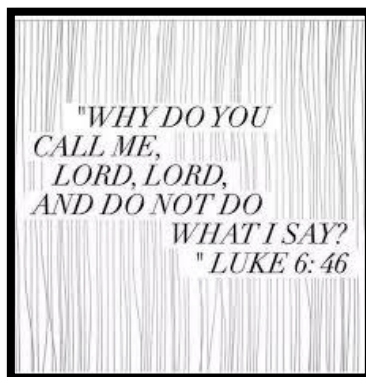

ELOHIM (Genesis 1:1 / Psalm 19:1) - All Powerful and mighty God

ADONAI (Malachi 1:6) - Lord

JEHOVAH or **YAHWEH** (Genesis 2:4) - God's divine salvation.

JEHOVAH – MACCADDSEHEM (Exodus 31:13) - The Lord who sanctifies

JEHOVAH – ROHI (Psalm 23:1) - my shepherd

JEHOVAH – SHAMMAH (Ezekiel 48:35) - The Lord who is present

JEHOVAH – RAPHA (Exodus 15:26) - our healer

JEHOVAH – TSIDKENU (Jeremiah 23:6) - our righteousness

JEHOVAH – JIREH (Genesis 22:13-14) - our provider

JEHOVAH – NISSI (Exodus 17:15) - our banner

JEHOVAH – SHALOM (Judges 6:24) - our peace

JEHOVAH – SABBAOTH (Isaiah 6:1-3) - The Lord of Hosts

JEHOVAH – GMOLAH (Jeremiah 51:6) = The God of Recompense

EL – ELYON (Genesis 14:17-20 / Isaiah 14:13-14) - The Most High God

EL – ROI (Genesis 16:13) - The Strong One who sees

EL – SHADDAI (Genesis 17:1 / Psalm 91:1) - The God of the mountains
or God Almighty

EL – OLAM (Isaiah 40:28-31) - the everlasting God

God's Names frequently are based on Who He is. This is how we worship a Holy Father God, in Spirit and in Truth (John 4:23-24); by knowing who our Heavenly Father really is!!! That's why Christ came – to reveal the Father to us (Matthew 11:27 / John 14:9-14).
