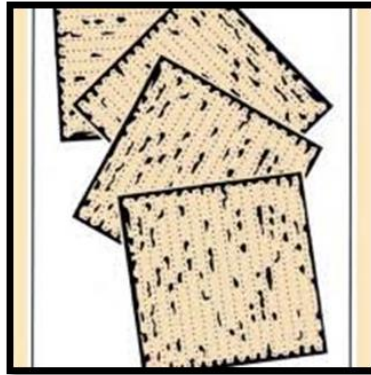


# First Day of Feast of Unleavened Bread

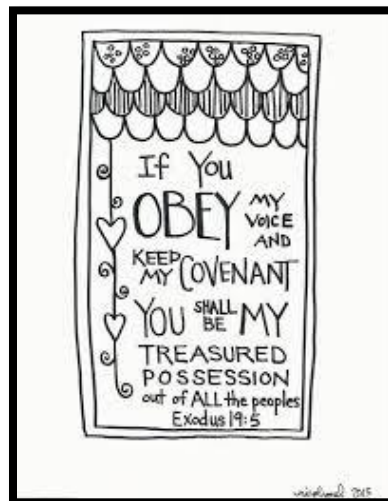

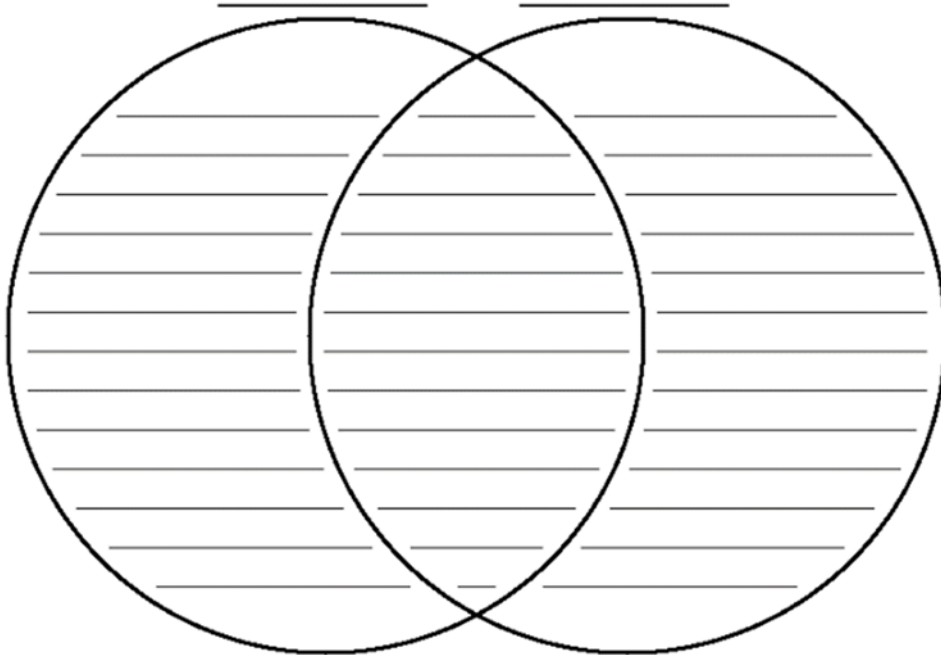

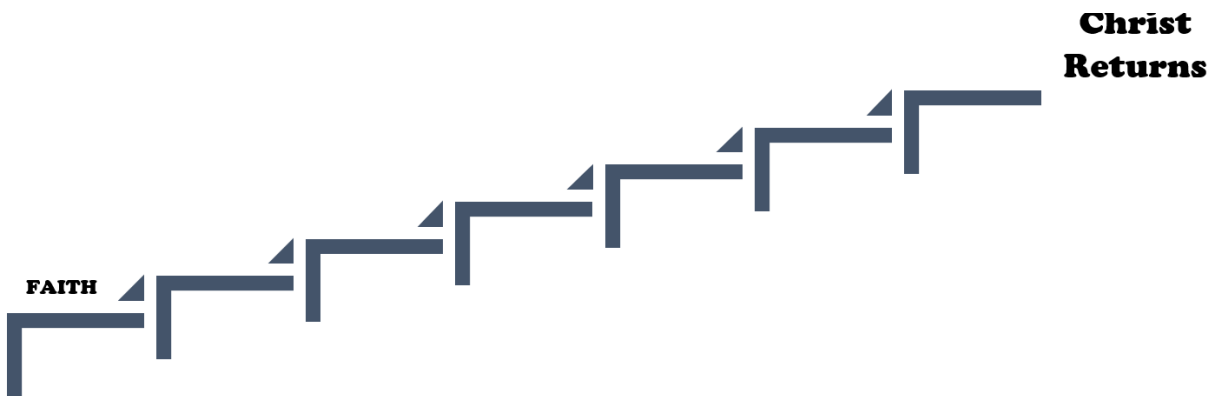
