The Meaning of This 50 Day Journey

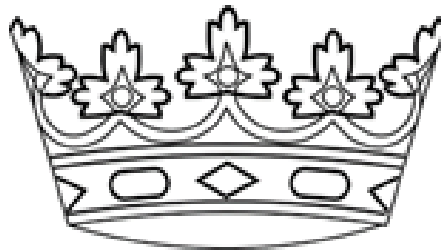
Based on what you read about the Israelites' 50 day journey today, what do you think God has intended that we do throughout the 50 day count to Pentecost?

How is the Word of God like a double-edged sword?

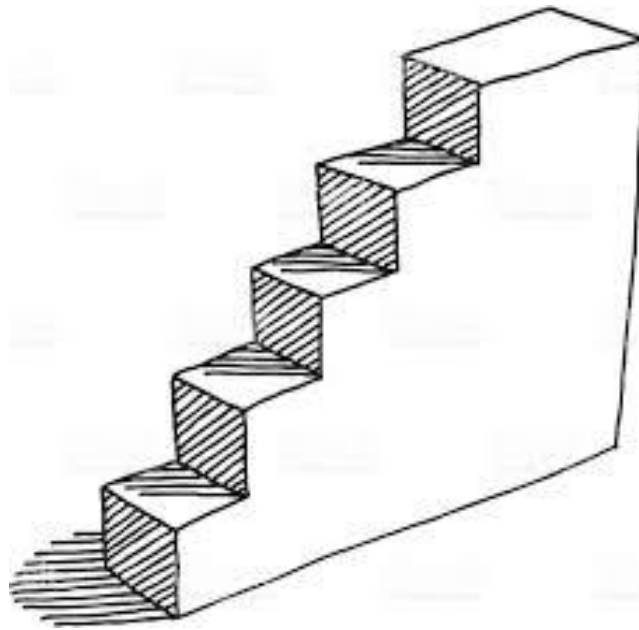
