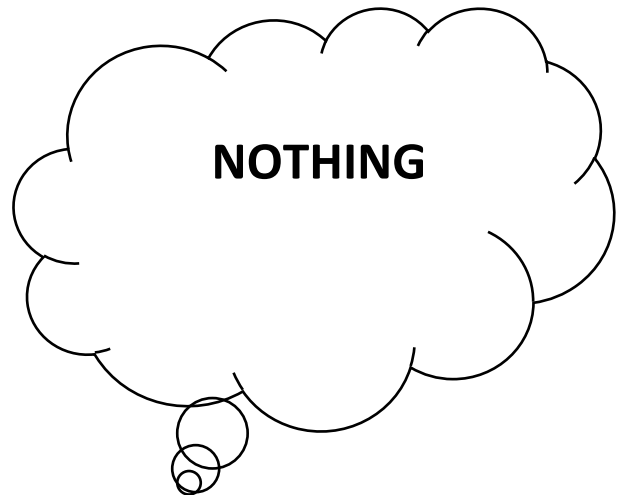

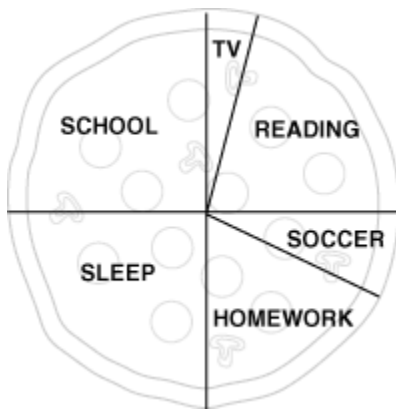

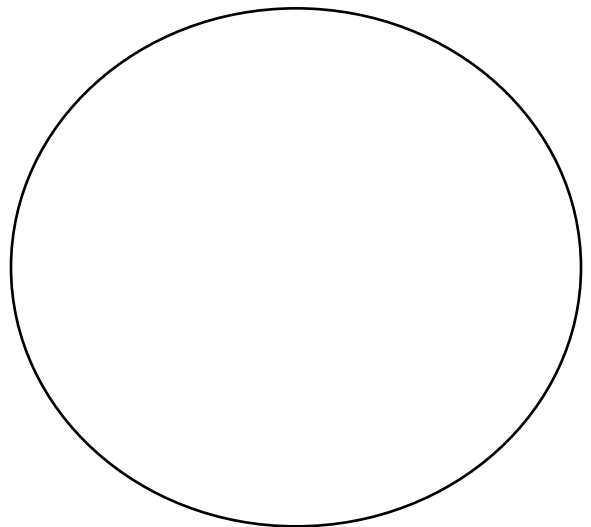
Self-Reflection
