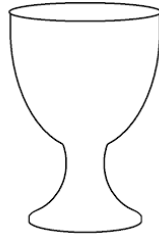


The Master's Cup – Passover Preparation

Wash Each Other's Feet

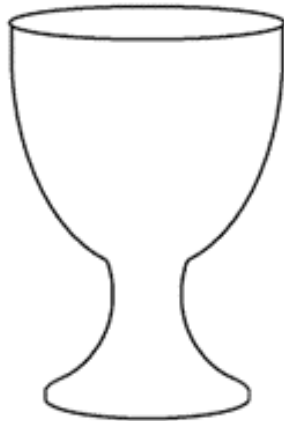


What did a cup bearer do for the king?
