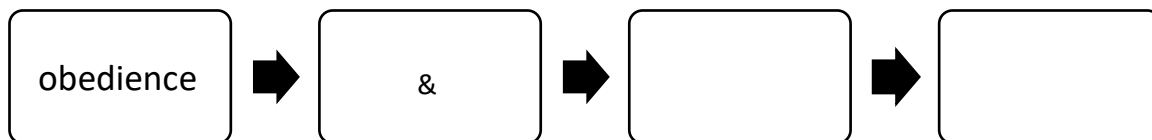

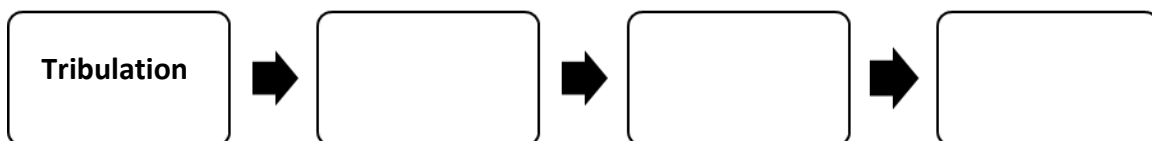


## Be Ready with an Answer
