Spring Feast Days BINGO Clues

MANNA – daily food God provided Israelites in the desert; used to re-teach Israelites about keeping the Sabbath

SIGN OF GOD – the keeping of the 7th day Sabbath (Saturday) and obeying God's Laws, including the keeping of the Holy Days

PASSOVER – memorial of Christ's death

FEAST OF UNLEAVENED BREAD – a 7-days designed for self-reflection; first & last days Holy

FIRST FRUITS – first and best offering to God; those He has called for the first resurrection

WAVE SHEAF – offering from the first crops; Christ's ascension to Heaven & sanctification before God

SIN – anything opposed to God's Laws; wages of unrepented ____ = death

GRACE – God's forgiveness when we disobey Him

GOD'S LAWS – rules we are to live by that benefit us, please God, and help us to become more like Him

REPENT – express remorse and sincere sorrow for sin; asking of forgiveness from God

STATUTE – commandment; law

GOD'S NEW YEAR – happens in the spring of the year; signaled by moon phase

LEAVEN – symbolizes sin in our lives

SABBATH – 7th day; blessed and sanctified by God

HOLY DAYS – days blessed by God; to be observed for specific reasons; shows us the plan of God

OBEDIENCE – If you love Me, show me _____.

DISCIPLE – obedient follower of Christ

BELIEVER – one who has faith in something

HIGH PRIEST – Christ

LAMB OF GOD – Christ; referring to His sacrifice for us to the Father (God)

RESURRECTION – coming back to life after death

WISDOM – the fear of the Lord is the beginning of _____

FAITH – confidence in God

VIRTUE – doing right & good

KNOWLEDGE – having information

UNDERSTANDING – application of knowledge

PATIENCE – tolerance of delay

GODLINESS – imitating Christ's virtues

BROTHERLY KINDNESS – having care & consideration for others

LOVE – deep devotion shown through obedience & gratitude

EXAMINE – look at carefully

FORGIVENESS – wiping away something done wrong

COVENANT – a serious agreement between two or more

WORTHY – deserving of something

PLAGUES – terrible diseases or catastrophes

BONDAGE – slave to something or someone

PENTECOST – grain harvest; Holy Spirit given; birth of God's church

CHRIST – First of the Firstfruits; our elder Brother; Passover Lamb
